Paid Work Experience Program - Important news

As we begin the paid work experience program we are finding that many of our students do not have the documents necessary to be employed. We will eventually be providing most of our students over the age of 16 with this opportunity this year. If you want your student to have this experience, please begin now gathering the following documents:

1. A **social security card**;
2. A **Florida identification card.** (school ID is not accepted). These can only be obtained through the DMV;
3. List of medications may be necessary when student has drug test;
4. **Banking information** for direct deposit (this can be parent's account).

If your student is over 16, please begin the process for obtaining all of this information so when it is his/her turn we can make the employment process easy.

All students who are employed will have to be drug tested as required by the employer.
